Moira Forbes graduated from St. Andrew's School in 1997. While a student here she participated in athletics all three seasons. Moira played field hockey, squash and lacrosse. She was a member of Model UN, French and Spanish clubs, a chapel monitor and worked on *The Andean* and *The Cardinal*.

Moira attended Princeton University and Harvard Business School. In 2001 she went to work for Forbes Media in London and in 2003 moved to New York to work for the *Forbes Lifestyle* magazine. In 2008 Moira launched *ForbesWoman*, dedicated to women in business and leadership. She is currently the President and Publisher of this publication. Ms. Forbes is also a columnist for *Forbes Magazine*. Moira is known for her one-on-one interviews with today's top female business leaders and is frequently a host and moderator for women's events around the world.

Her grandfather, Malcolm Forbes, was the founder of *Forbes Magazine*. Moira is one of five daughters of Steve and Sabina Forbes. Her father was a candidate for President of the United States in 1996 and again in 2000. He is currently the editor-in-chief of Forbes and her mother is a long standing trustee of St. Andrew's School.

In 2008 Moira married Dr. John Anderson and they have one son, Malcolm, born last spring.

The Moira Stevenson Forbes Theater was dedicated in her honor on February 20, 1998 which coincided with opening night of the winter musical, *Meet Me in St. Louis*.
