During spring break two members of the St. Andrew's Orchestra earned substantial recognition. Cellist **Katherine Haroldson** '12successfully competed in the "Delaware Idols" National String Competition, held at the University of Delaware. Selected on the basis of an initial video audition, Katherine advanced to the final round of competition and placed third for her performance of the Saint-Saens Cello Concerto. She gave a beautiful performance in the Winners' Recital on Sunday, March 18. "Katherine played this concerto with our orchestra last year," said Director of Instrumental Music Fred Geiersbach. "She knows the piece well and continues to find new and more sophisticated ways of shaping her interpretation. I was very impressed with her showing in this competition."

It will also be fascinating to find out how high she places in these orchestras – she has the talent to go all the way to the top."
