You can pick up your child on Friday, June 4 between the hours of 6:00 PM 9:00 PM ET, or on Saturday, June 5, between the hours of 9:00 AM 3:00 PM ET.
- We have extremely limited storage on campus for student possessions.
   International students and students who must fly home from campus are prioritized.
   Anything that needs to be shipped home prior to the end of school is the responsibility of students (not the school).

## **Health Center Updates**

#### **Vaccine Clinic Update!**


We vaccinated 254 students at our second Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine clinic on Wednesday. SAS nurses administered 63 first doses and 175 second doses to students. Sixty percent of current students have now received two doses of the vaccine, and, when combined with our 18 previously fully vaccinated students, 80% of current students have now received at least one dose or more of the vaccine! Huge thanks to the Health Center Team, and especially Mrs. Rickolt, Mrs. Ketzner, and Mrs. Carrico, for their tireless work to make this clinic a reality. Parents, all students who have received a dose of the vaccine have received a vaccination card. We have also scanned a copy of each card for inclusion in their St. Andrew's electronic medical record.

Go Saints!


